Minutes

1. For class representatives to feedback on their meetings with their classes

- Children fed back all of the ideas their classes had on how Elson and Gomer Infant schools could link together. The thinking hats were used to decide good and bad points about the ideas before we made a final list:



Ideas

- School trips together especially if we are doing the same topics
- Visiting each other's schools - a Gomer class (or a group of children) go to Elson class for the day. The children thought they should also have an Elson teacher for the day - either the whole class visiting or the teacher visiting us.

- Emails

2. To decide on how the pupil voice group can feedback to our Governors
