We will also learn about shapes and their properties

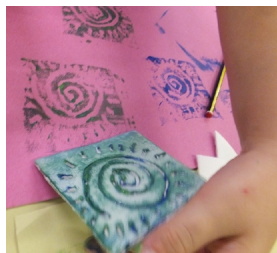
## R.E.
