

In Geography we will be recording our daily temperature and comparing it with Antananarivo in Madagascar. We will also be studying the human and physical differences between these 2 places.



In Literacy the children will be set a weekly challenge by the story master to earn objects by telling/ writing exciting stories. We will be reading variations of traditional stories, maybe with a different ending or from a different characters point of view. This will be the basis for a range of writing with a strong focus on spelling, punctuation and grammar. In Guided Reading we will be looking for links and connections between a range of texts.



Science

In Science our focus will be healthy living by understanding the need for exercise and the importance of different food groups. We will be planning and carrying our own experiments and making conclusions from our findings.



Maths

We will deepen our knowledge of 2d and 3d shapes. We will continue to calculate using 4 operations, ensuring we are using efficient strategies.




Art/ DT

We will be learning techniques to join clay successfully such as dragging, slipping and cross hatching to produce a final product.
