Science

We will learn about how materials can be changed. We will be investigating those changes that are reversible and those that are not.

We will plan & design our own experiments making predictions, drawing conclusions and evaluating how the experiments were carried out.



Maths

We will revisit place value to consolidate or deepen our understanding through problem solving.
