We will also learn about shapes and their properties.

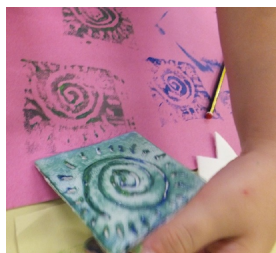
## R.E.
