Aims

To look at our understanding of types of mistakes EG sloppy and what that means.

Minutes

1. We talked about what it feels like when we have made a mistake in our learning – some children said it felt sad because they had done it wrong or it was too hard. The Year Two children talked more about how you can learn from a mistake and make their learning better.
2. Year Two understood that a “sloppy mistake” was a mistake that can be corrected by themselves if they check their work carefully and before the teacher sees it. If they have not checked their work and the teacher spots it then it’s “sloppy”.
3. All children knew that “sky blue” was for improving their learning.
