### Aims

1. To find out how children select their reading and library books from the library

### **Minutes**

1. Mrs White has asked us to talk about how children select their reading books and library books when going to the library
2. Reading Books – Children said that they often just take a book from the coloured level box after only looking at the cover. Others said that they like to look at the cover, flick through the book and look at the pictures and how many words there are. They also check to make sure they have not read it before.
3. Library Books – Children said they spend more time choosing their library book. Year Two said that they like to use the “Where to look” posters when choosing a non-fiction book. All of the children said they like to find books that they like when looking for a fiction book EG. Looking through the book for animals (if that is their favourite), dragons, dinosaurs or fairies. They also like to look for their favourite author like Julia Donaldson.
4. Mrs White joined us at the end of the meeting so that we could feedback what we had found out.
