Literacy



Our focus will be on writing persuasive letters & posters to help care for our local environment and reporting to the school about how we can all work together to help protect our planet. Our SPaG (Spelling, Punctuation and Grammar) focus will be identifying & writing different sentence types—statements, questions, exclamations & commands.

Maths



We will be using our knowledge of place value to help us calculate more efficiently. We will also apply our skills to calculate with money. We will develop our understanding of fractions.

Science

We will observe how seeds & blubs grow & identify & test best conditions for growth. We will also start a long term study—collecting data & analysing the results.



Forest Learning

In the forest we will be looking after our immediate environment and using our mapping skills.



Geography

We will be using globes, atlases & IT to identify continents & oceans. We will consider the pollution problems being faced globally especially plastic pollution.

Our focus will be on looking closely to produce detailed observational drawing—including line, texture & colour.

Computing



We will be collecting data & using computers to represent the data accurately in a variety of formats.

We will focus on the concept of authority. This will be related to Jesus as an authority figure for Christians.

Our focus will be on contributing to simple debates. These will focus on the important issues of pollution and caring for our environment. We will consider how we can make a difference within our immediate environment.
