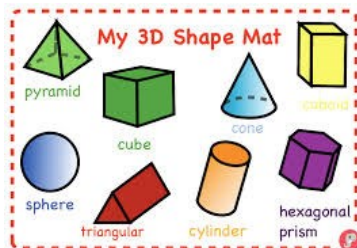

Mathematical development

The children will learn about 3D shapes and their properties. We will continue to learn about addition and subtraction and learn methods to record calculations.



We will use everyday words to describe time including days of the week, months of the year and block's of time during the day.



Communication, language and literacy

We will be able to use our phonics to build words for reading and writing and to communicate through questioning and answering.



Physical development

We will be emphasising shape when curling, stretching and balancing. We will learn to make movements to match music in dance. We will be developing skills in hopping, skipping, jumping and introduce low apparatus.



Creative development

We will be creating repeated sounds and sound patterns. We will also be using instruments to make loud, soft, high and low sounds. The children will learn different movement responses in relation to different types of music. We will learn songs about Easter and new life. We will be using clay as a media to create mini beasts.



Knowledge and understanding of the world

We will be looking for signs of new life and to learning the names of the seasons. We will begin to understand why people have eggs at Easter. Also we will find out about how animals grow and change and how to care for them.

We will be talking about our own feelings and the feelings of others. We will talk about what makes us unique and how it is ok to be different. We will be using the learning powers Reflective Detective to build skills in taking on challenge in our learning and how to improve from a first draft.
