

Year 1 Topic Planner

Autumn 2 2020

History

We will be finding out the differences and similarities between the toys the children play with and with the toys parents and Grandparents played with.

Literacy

We will continue to develop our phonic skills in reading and use the sounds we know to write good sentences.

We are revising our kinetic letters in handwriting and working on starting every letter on the correct monkey branch and remembering if they are pushing or pulling letters.

We will be sharing some rhyming texts such as Each Peach Pear Plum, and through December reading lots of exciting Christmas stories.



Maths

We will continue with our learning on calculating by addition and subtraction. We will be encouraged to make choices as the best resources to use to solve calculation problems. We will be setting a challenge for the children to know all the pairs of numbers that make 10 by heart.

We will be revising 2D and 3D shapes.

DT

We will be using cutting and joining skills to make a simple hand puppet.

This half term Year 1 will be focused around the topic:

Toy Story



Computing

We will be focusing on programming toys. We will learn how to input instructions (algorithms) for Beebots.

RE

RE will focus on messengers. We will be learning about the significance of Angels as religious symbols. We will explore Christian beliefs about the story of Christmas and discuss how this festival is celebrated around the world.

Science

In our science learning we will be investigating materials through the context of toys. We will also be using the forest area to look at seasonal changes.

Music—We will be learning how to clap in a rhythm and use percussion instruments in a rhythm.

Art—We will be experimenting with tones, tints and shades of colour—using a variety of media.

PΕ

In P.E we will be challenging ourselves to develop our ball skills. We will include partner games to develop co-operation and turn taking skills. In gym, we will focus on holding controlled balances on a variety of body parts and linking jumps, balances and travelling to create simple sequences.



PSE

Our work in PHSE will be focussing on positive friendships, including recognising what we are good at and what our friends are good at. We will be developing collaboration and teamwork skills. Our learning powers focus will be based around the character 'Seger'. This character will model what to do when our learning is tricky and how to manage distractions to our learning.
