To develop skills in using bats, balls and beanbags to push, pat, throw, catch and kick.

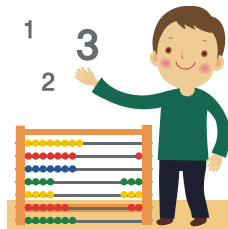


To use PE apparatus safely and begin to risk assess for ourselves.
