**Risk Assessment- Gomer Infant School- Stay and Play sessions June/July 2021**

**Risk- Transmission of virus due to close contact**

**Steps taken to mitigate risk**

**We are very much looking forward to welcoming you to our school for the up and coming Stay and Play sessions. We are really keen to be able to run the sessions in “real life” but as you will understand it is crucial for us to follow the guidelines and restrictions that are still in place.**

**Please can we ask you to kindly take note of the following Health and safety points below:**

- Please can we ask that all adults wear masks whilst on site.
- Group sizes have been kept low in number so that that adults and children can distance appropriately.
- Only 1 adult per child to attend the session (no siblings)
- A member of the Senior Leadership Team will be at the Ladram Road entrance gate to guide you to your child’s new class.
- Please sign in to the sessions (a sign in sheet will be outside of your child’s new classroom)
- Our aim is that the stay and play sessions will be primarily based outside.
- There will be the opportunity for the children to spend time in their new classroom but please can we ask that there is a maximum of 3 children and 3 parents in any room at one time.

**Wet weather:**

- Should it be raining during your session at the school, the content of the sessions will change slightly and the session will go ahead under some cover (for the children) with a circle time, song and singing. If the weather is wet then please bring an umbrella for yourself as we have limited shelter for adults.
