

Year 2 Topic Planner: Remembering

Autumn 2 2021

Curriculum Intent: Our focus for this term is to consider why it is important to remember special events. We will focus on Remembrance Day and key events of the World Wars, and their impact upon Gosport. We will also remember the birth of Jesus through the Christian celebration of Christmas.





Literacy— Phonics— We will continue to use and apply our phonic skills when reading and writing and begin to learn spelling rules. Our literacy learning will be focussed upon the text of 'Flo of the Somme' and 'The Bear and the Hare'. We will use this to learn about different sentence types and to use adjectives to add detail to our writing.



Maths— We will be learning how to calculate efficiently to solve problems, using multiplication and division as well as addition and subtraction. We will learn how to measure length accurately and continue to name and describe the properties of common 2d and 3d shapes.

History— We will launch our learning with a visit to Stokes Bay to look at the memorials on the prom, and also consider why it is important that we remember the war and those who were involved. We will also be comparing Christmas celebrations now, with how Christmas celebrations were in Victorian times.

Science— We will be continuing with our long term weather study based on investigations decided by the children. We will also learn about the properties of different materials and use this to find the best material to help

RE— We will consider the importance of light as a symbol for Christians. We will learn about the Advent wreath and Christingle and remember our learning about the importance of light as a symbol for Sikhs.



DT— We will be investigating a variety of joining techniques for different materials to design and make a picture frame.

PE— Our focus will be on dance and gym skills. We will be working collaboratively, and developing our coaching skills to help others improve.

Music— We will be continuing to learn to play the ukulele with Hampshire Music Service and will performing in a concert later in the term.



Forest - We will be applying our measuring skills in the forest. There will also be a linked Christmas challenge.



PSHE (Jigsaw) - Our Jigsaw focus is on celebrating differences between individuals and respecting all equally.




Art— We will focus on paint mixing skills and using shades and tones to create levels of colour. We will also learn the skill of paper mache to design and create a Christmas bauble.
