
Uniform Requirements

It is nearly time to think about your child's first infant school uniform, we know this is an exciting time for you all! Below is our school uniform list. (Items in bold are required.)

School Uniform

Black/Grey Trousers/Skirt/Pinafore dress or Shorts White/ Red Polo Shirt
Red Logo / or Plain Red Sweatshirt or Cardigan White/ Black/ Grey Socks/ Tights
Black Shoes
Red Book Bag (logo or plain)
Red Gingham Dress (optional, in warmer weather)
Sun hat – any type
Wellington boots – any type

PE Kit Black Shorts (no drawstring) White/Red Logo T-shirt or Plain White/Red T-shirt PE Logo Zipped Hoody (optional) Plimsolls – (plain, not required until the Spring term)





All logo uniform is optional, you are able to purchase plain items of uniform from other retailers, including second hand retailers (e.g. Jacobs Well, or pre-loved uniform sales in school).

The link to order uniform and to also order name labels can also be found on our 'Starting School' page on the school website. We also recommend you label your child's clothing.

PE will not start for Year R until Autumn 2 term, outdoor PE for Year R will not start until the Spring term so we would advise you not to purchase plimsols for September. The class teacher will advise you of your child\s allocated PE day nearer the time.

Please can earrings be **removed** for PE days, or if your child is able to remove the earrings on their own these can be placed into an envelope. This is for the safety of your child and others. If ears have been pierced recently then we will tape them until healed (normally 2 weeks).

At Gomer Infant School any child eligible for FSM Pupil Premium will receive 1 x logo sweatshirt or cardigan at the start of each new academic year.

FSM Pupil premium is available to children whose parents/guardians are in receipt of one or more of the following benefits:

- Income Support
- Income-based Job Seekers' Allowance
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- The guaranteed element of State Pension Credit
- Child Tax Credit, provided you are not also entitled to Working Tax Credit, and have an annual gross
 income, of no more than £16,190 as assessed by Her Majesty's Revenue and Customs (Parents who are
 made redundant or start working less than 16 hours per week, may find their children are entitled to free
 meals for a limited period.)
- Working Tax Credit run-on paid for 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit
- Universal Credit (provided you have an annual net earned income of no more than £7,400, as assessed by earnings from up to three of your most recent assessment periods)

No other benefits qualify for pupil premium.
