


Year 2 Curriculum Overview - Remembering

Curriculum Intent: Our focus for this term is to consider why it is important to remember special events. We will learn about Remembrance Day. We will also remember the birth of Jesus through the Christian celebration of Christmas.










Maths— We will be learning how to calculate efficiently to solve problems, using multiplication and division as well as addition and subtraction. We will learn how to measure length accurately and continue to name and describe the properties of common 2d and 3d shapes.

History— We will launch our learning with the arrival of a History Box containing lots of artefacts from Victorian Life. We will investigate these sources and answer the question: "How has life changed since Victorian times?" in particular we will compare Christmas celebrations now, with how Christmas celebrations were in Victorian times.







PE— Our focus will be on dance and gym skills. We will be working collaboratively, and developing our coaching skills to help others improve.


